Care and Maintenance Instructions

READ THIS FIRST

Primal Seat Covers have NOT been washed before shipment. In order to help prevent die run, we recommend the end user wash the seat covers at least 3 times on a delicate wash cycle (without soap) to ensure the die has been set. Adding vinegar to the wash cycle will also help set the die. After the third wash, take a dark colored seat cover and place on a white paper towel and let dry. Before using any of the dark colored seat covers, be sure to see if any color from the seat cover has transferred onto the white towel. If so, re-wash covers until die transfer has been eliminated.

Washing

Wash in cold water only on a delicate cycle.

Drying

Dry seat covers on low or cool setting. Primal Seat Covers have NOT been pre-shunk, so to ensure the proper fit over the lifetime of the product, continue to dry on low.

Maintaining Thread Pulls

If a thread pull appears, DO NOT pull the thread by hand. Pulling the thread will make the problem worse. Simply trim the thread pull with scissors and watch it disappear.

How to Use Primal Seat Covers

Primal Seat Covers are NOT meant to be left on the cushions for long periods of time. Damp covers left on for more than a few days could create mildew. During constant use periods, such as boat camping or houseboat trips, covers should be dried every other day. For day usage, simply remove covers and hang dry or tumble dry on low heat before your next outing. Primal Seat Covers are not a replacement for normal vinyl care and maintenance. Vinyl should continue to be dried after each boat usage to prevent mildew from occurring. Vinyl moisturizer should also be used periodically.

Primal Seat Covers can be used while trailering your boat. It is necessary to pre-check each cover to make sure it is properly installed before starting your journey.

Disclosure

Primal Seat Covers are made from towel and lycra material commonly found at retail stores. When using any fabric, there is always the risk of die transferring to other materials.
